2. Hazard Identification

Not classified as hazardous according to WHS Regulations. Not a Dangerous Good according to the ADG Code.
May cause some irritation to the eye – if in eyes, rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
Unlikely to irritate the skin.

4. First aid

In case of eye contact, wash out the eye thoroughly with plenty of clean running water. If irritation occurs or persists, seek medical advice.

In case of skin contact outside of its normal use, remove contaminated clothing and wash the skin with running water. Seek medical advice if skin irritation develops.

In case of ingestion, rinse out the mouth with water and consult a physician or Poisons Information Centre.

If inhalation of fumes, vapours or decomposition products are suspected, remove from contaminated area into fresh air. Other measures are not normally necessary.

5. Fire-fighting measures

Put out any fire with dry chemical powder, foam, sand or water spray. The product is unlikely to support combustion due to its water content. Use water spray for large fires only.

Carbon dioxide and carbon monoxide may be produced in the case of fire.

In case of fire, self-contained breathing apparatus must be worn.

In case of fire, cool fire exposed storage tanks or containers with water spray.

6. Accidental release measures

Personal precautions: Clean up personnel should wear full protective clothing to prevent contact with skin, eyes and personal clothing. Remove non-essential personnel from the area and restrict access until fully cleaned up. Ensure adequate ventilation.

Environmental precautions: Prevent spills or run-off from entering stormwater drains or waterways.

Methods of cleaning up: Stop any leakage if safe to do. Contain the spill using liquid-absorbing material such as sand, peat, sawdust or other inert materials. Collect clean-up material and place in suitable labelled containers, and refer to local regulations for waste disposal. Small residual amounts may be washed with copious amounts of cold water to sewer.

7. Handling and storage.

Safe Handling: Washing hands thoroughly after handling; and do not eat, drink or smoke while handling the product. Take care to minimize splashes or spills when decanting, and avoid physical damage to containers.

Safe Storage: Store in its original container at ambient temperatures between 5 to 40°C, in a well-ventilated area. Keep container tightly sealed.

8. Exposure control/ personal protection

Engineering Controls: Not normally required

Skin protection: Wear protective gloves, e.g PVC, when cleaning spills or where prolonged, repetitive or unintended skin contact (outside of normal usage) may be encountered.

Eye and face protection: Not required under normal usage conditions. Safety glasses or chemical resistant goggles should be worn when cleaning large spills or when decanting to protect eyes from splashing.
